Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

I would like to start again with a general and positive update.

I spent yesterday with a very experienced School Advisor and the headlines from the report produced were that our children were very enthusiastic and engaged in their learning and that they clearly enjoyed school and were making strong academic progress. These are particularly pleasing findings as they reflect well on the whole school community: parents/carers, St Keyna staff and most importantly the children.

On a personal note, it was a pleasure for me to be able to step back and see a whole day of excellent teaching and learning!

Building works:

Next term, the building works will start to cause more significant disruption. There will be new safety fencing from the fence between the KS1 and KS2 playground and also alongside the far edge of our Year 4 classroom. This will mean a loss of playground space, which we can work around but also it will be impossible to walk around the outside of the school in a loop. We will also have a new fire and evacuation procedure in place for the new term.

On a positive note, once the earth removal and foundations are completed, the new building, which is timber-framed, will go up quickly. We expect the building to be constructed during the Autumn and it is well on-track for September 2025, when we will no longer have any spare classes.

I would like to add a **huge thank you to FOSK and any volunteers**, who are helping with preparing the ground for a new play house for the Early Years play area – a much harder job than it appears at first sight.
